One of the most frustrating challenges in violin playing is when the teacher and parent instruct the student to “bow straight,” and the student exclaims, “I am!” They may not be, not because it is their fault, but because it is an optical illusion from the point of view of the player. One can never be sure if straight is actually straight.

After years of struggle with this dilemma, I stumbled on a realization. It would be much easier if the student understood the mechanics and muscle memory for correct bowing. Tedious repetition of the mechanical instructions often did not bring success.

I realized that what was needed was a device that taught the student the mechanics of bowing and the imprinted muscle memory instantly. Teaching the student to bow correctly needed a tool—a kind of training wheels for a violin. Thus was invented the Bowright™.
